#### **Brief Report**

Due to unavoidable circumstances, we were unable to carry out the project within the original timeframe. The main reasons were the closure of roads that transport construction materials and the unavailability of skilled laborers, most of whom come from other states of India. This led to a delay of a few months.

We are, however, pleased to report that the Old People's Home Laundry and Drainage System has now been successfully completed. The longstanding laundry problem has been resolved, and the elderly residents are already benefitting from this facility.

Previously, washing clothes manually, especially during the harsh winter months, was extremely difficult. Now, with the installation of washing machines in a safer and warmer location, both the residents and the staff can manage laundry more efficiently and comfortably.
